### Activity Permission Form (SPS Covid Disclosure and Release)

Due to the Covid pandemic, students participating in the summer marching band must have a special release form on file indicating awareness of the risk and holding the district harmless. That form is the last two pages of this packet and should be printed and brought with you to your first rehearsal.

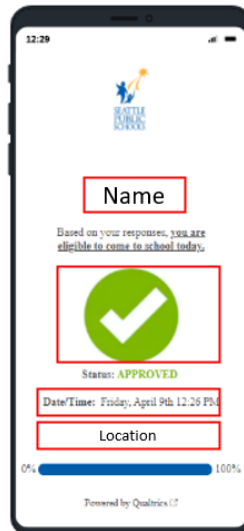
### Pre-Arrival to Memorial Stadium –

Prior to arriving at Memorial Stadium, students and staff will be **required** to complete the **Seattle Public Schools COVID-19 Attestation**, managed by the Qualtrics platform. The attestation must be completed daily and you can access the form by clicking this **\*\*\*LINK\*\*\*** or by scanning the QR code below with your smart device. Please select **“Memorial Stadium”** as the SPS School Site.

Once you have completed the attestation, please take a screenshot of the screen that shows the green check mark. You will be asked to show us that approval upon entering Memorial Stadium.

If you have a red “X”, please do not come to All-City that day. Please stay home and contact your healthcare provider.

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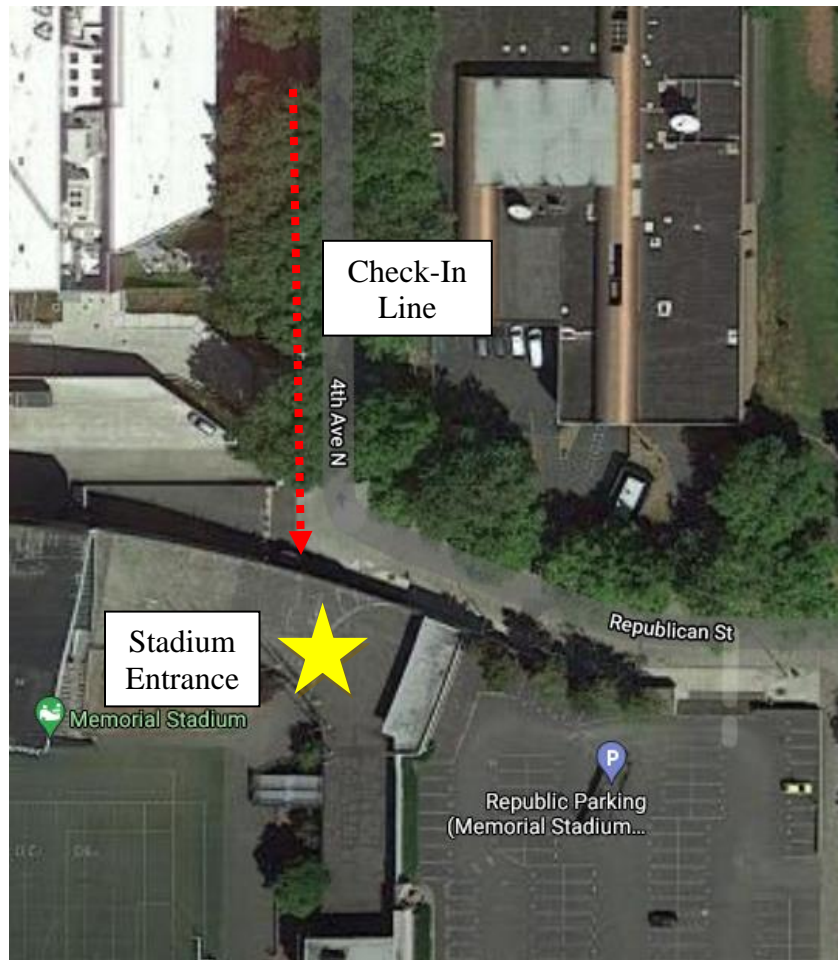

## Arrival to Memorial Stadium –

When you arrive at Memorial Stadium, all students and staff will enter through the Players Entrance door located on the corner of 4<sup>th</sup> Ave. N and Republican St for check-in. Please have your screenshot readily available to show the staff member at the check-in table. If you were unable to complete your attestation before arriving, you will need to complete it before being allowed to proceed into the facility. If you do not have access to a smart device to complete the attestation, we will have alternative methods at the check-in table for you. Should you receive a red "X", you will be ask to leave immediately OR wait for your parent/guardian/caregiver in the designated isolation area. Please remember that **MASKS ARE REQUIRED AT ALL TIMES** while in the footprint of Memorial Stadium. The line for check-in will run down 4<sup>th</sup> Ave N as indicated by the dotted red line. Please remember to social distance and maintain 6 feet away from others.





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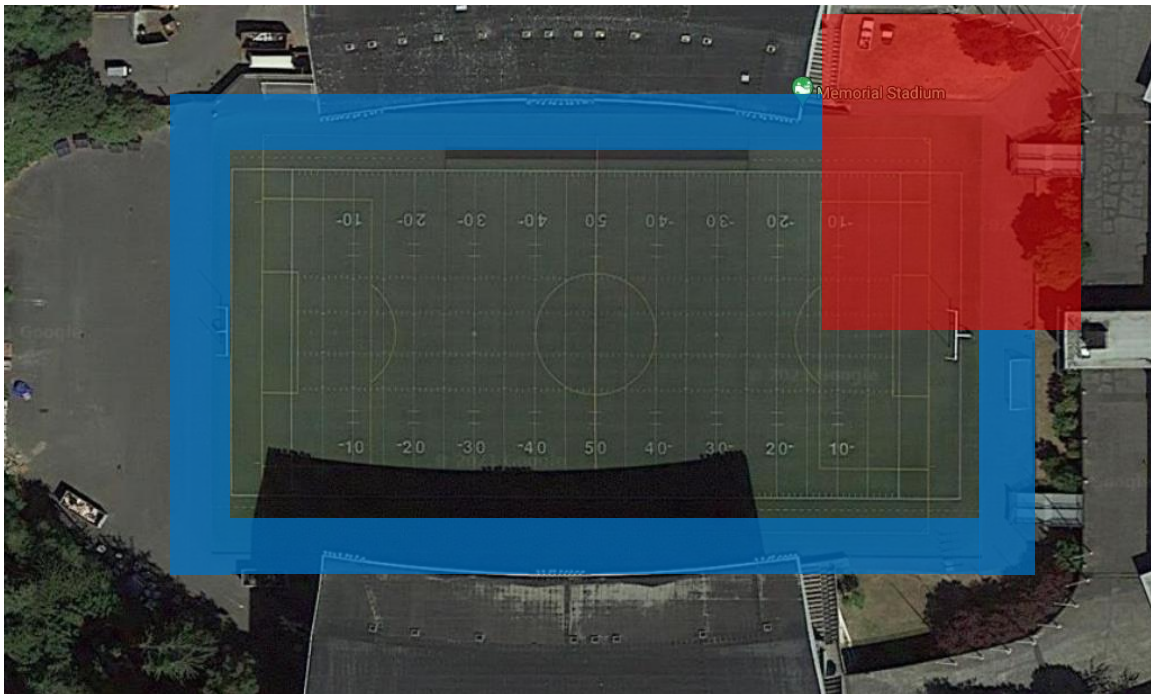
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## Check-In Process

At check-in, a staff member will check that you have completed the mandatory attestation and have been approved to attend rehearsal that day. You will be provided with an instrument bell cover or an instrument cover bag on the first day of rehearsal. It will be your responsibility to keep this PPE with you all summer. If you lose or damage the instrument PPE issued to you, it will be your responsibility to purchase a replacement. You will also be given a single-use surgical mask daily that has a slit in it. During music rehearsal, you will take your cloth mask off and put your surgical mask on.

## Case/Personal Belongings

Upon successfully checking in, Instrument cases and personal belongings can be stored within the areas marked in **BLUE** below. Your section staff will designate a zone within that area for your section. Please remember to social distance. Please stay clear of the check-in area (marked in **RED**) after you have completed check-in.



## Large Instrument/Equipment Storage

Drumline and Low Brass will store their instruments in Locker Room #3. The capacity of the storage room is 2 people at a time. The Locker Room corridor will be one-way traffic from North to South.



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## **During Rehearsal**

Please socially distance at all times and maintain a minimum of 9' from other band members and staff. The staff have designed the rehearsal plan to ensure that everything that is asked of you can be accomplished while socially distancing. You will be assigned a dot number within the drill chart and your section staff will assist you in getting to your "dot". During music rehearsal (and anytime that you are playing your instrument while marching), you will take your cloth mask off and put your surgical mask on. During marching rehearsal that does not involve playing instruments, you will only need to wear your cloth mask. It is recommended that you wear both your surgical mask and cloth mask during marching rehearsal for the ease of switching between music and marching rehearsals and creates an added layer of protection.

## **Restrooms:**

Restrooms are located in Locker Room #1 (Men's) and Locker Room #4 (Women's). The Locker Room corridor will be one-way traffic from North to South. The capacity of the restrooms is 2 people at a time.

## **Water and Food:**

Water fountains are not available at Memorial Stadium. Students and staff should bring their own water to rehearsal. Please bring enough water with you to ensure that you are properly hydrated for the duration of rehearsal. There is to be no sharing of food or drinks. Food/Snacks are not allowed to be consumed on the playing surface at any time.

## **Post-Rehearsal:**

Students will be asked to leave Memorial Stadium as soon as practice concludes. There is no socializing to take place within Memorial Stadium and remember to socially distance when walking back to your vehicle.

## **Additional Notes:**

- When walking around Memorial Stadium, you should have your masks on at **ALL TIMES**. The masks should fully cover both your mouth and your nose.
- When it is time to play, you may remove your cloth mask and put it in your pocket. The surgical mask should stay on at ALL TIMES. If you are not playing your instrument for an extended period of time, you should put your cloth mask back on over the surgical mask.
- Hand sanitizer will be provided near all touch points. Please use the provided hand sanitizer as often as possible after touching any public or communal surfaces.

### COVID-19 NOTICE FROM SEATTLE SCHOOL DISTRICT ("DISTRICT")

The novel coronavirus ("COVID-19") has been classified by the World Health Organization as a global pandemic and has spread across the state of Washington. COVID-19 is a new disease and the state of scientific and medical knowledge regarding COVID-19 is limited and evolving. There remain unknowns regarding how the disease is spread and contracted and there is currently no known treatment, cure, or vaccine for COVID-19. COVID-19 is reported to be highly contagious and spread easily from person to person. **COVID-19 may result in serious illness, debilitating injury, or death.** Older adults and people of any age, including children, who have serious underlying medical conditions might be at higher risk for severe illness or death from COVID-19.

The District has put in place measures in an effort to reduce the spread of COVID-19. However, notwithstanding any such efforts, it is simply not possible to guarantee that COVID-19 is not present nor to prevent you or your child from becoming exposed to, contracting, or spreading COVID-19. By entering District premises, attending school in-person, attending or participating in District activities in-person, and/or attending or participating in **this Sport** ("Activity"), you and your child are exposed to the risk of contracting or spreading COVID-19. By participating in certain activities associated with greater rates of disease transmission, you and your child are exposed to a high risk of contracting or spreading COVID-19. Activities that may pose a high risk for COVID-19 include (but are not limited to): group transportation, singing, choir, exercise, athletics, any activity where people are closer than 6 feet apart, any large gathering of people indoors, and this Activity.

### ASSUMPTION OF RISK, WAIVER OF LIABILITY, HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

**Assumption of Risk for COVID-19:** I understand that my child's participation in this Activity is voluntary and is not required. By signing below, I acknowledge that I have carefully read the above; understand the risks of COVID-19 associated with entering District premises or facilities, attending school in-person, participating in District activities in-person, and/or participating in this Activity. I voluntarily assume such risks, including the risk of serious illness, debilitating injury, or death to my child and myself. By signing below, I further acknowledge that I understand that the risk of exposure to, contracting, or spreading COVID-19 may result from the acts, omissions, or negligence
